All shelters must be large enough for one person to sleep in.

Materials used in building the shelter are limited to:

Cardboard
Paper
Styrofoam
Fabric
String
Tape
Staples
Markers
Crayons
Battery Operated Lights



Participants may start building their shelter at the church after 7:00 p.m. or bring it to the church already assembled.

Judging will take place between 9:00 & 9:30 p.m. with winner announced by 10:00 p.m.

Shelters will be judged on the creativity, functionality, and uniqueness of the design. First, second and third prizes will be awarded.

Building Groups provide all their own materials. Unless your shelter is selected to be part of the Souderton Holiday parade, groups are responsible to dismantle shelters and recycle cardboard (trailer provided on site) by 8:00 a.m. on the 13th and dispose of any other materials.
